Communication and outreach activities

This is a brief report on communications activities since the 42nd Session of the Panel in Dubrovnik in October 2015.

Communications Strategy

The Communications Action Team, a sub-group of the IPCC Executive Committee set up under the Communications Strategy, has met twice. Once the Technical Support Units have been set up it will meet more regularly.

AR5 Outreach Programme

An outreach event hosted by the University of Miami Rosenstiel School of Marine and Atmospheric Science was held on 12-13 November, with the participation of the Chair of the IPCC, Working Group II Co-Chair Mr Hans-Otto Pörtner, IPCC authors from the University of Miami, the Caribbean and Latin America, other University of Miami scientists, and practitioners from Florida and the Caribbean. The IPCC funded the participation of 10 participants from the Caribbean island states. There was a request for a follow-up event to be held on one of the islands. An outreach event was also held in Croatia (<u>http://ipcc.ch/apps/outreach/eventinfo.php?q=317</u>), speakers were provided to a non-specialist event in the French Alps (Rencontres Alpines on 23 November <u>http://www.rencontresalpines.org/</u>), and African authors and secretariat staff took part in the Climate Change and Development in Africa meeting at Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe at the end of October (<u>http://ipcc.ch/apps/outreach/eventinfo.php?q=319</u>).

Approximately CHF 300,000 remains in the Fifth Assessment Report outreach budget, which will allow further events to be conducted in 2016, but we will need to turn to the generosity of member states and other donors to help us continue at the same pace.

21st Conference of the Parties (COP21) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change

IPCC speakers were in high demand for media interviews and side events at the 21st Conference of the Parties (COP21) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, given the role of the IPCC in the implementation of the Paris Agreement, interest in the new Bureau and cycle, and the need for scientific explanations of the impacts of 1.5^oC and 2.0^oC. There was also keen interest from officials to meet the new Chair and other Bureau members.
